*Steward Punta Cana Farm and Ecological Reserve*

Background	<p>The Punta Cana Ecological Foundation has undertaken a pilot project in sustainable agriculture since 2003. The farm provides educational opportunities for students, tourists and the community as a whole to learn about local flora, fauna and conservation. The Punta Cana Farm includes a fruit tree garden, bee keeping area, organic compost, a petting zoo and a rhinoceros iguana refuge.</p> <p>The Indigenous Eyes Ecological Reserve is 1,500 acres of forest preserve owned and managed by PUNTACANA Ecological Foundation. The reserve is a part of a lowland subtropical tropical forest decorated with eleven freshwater lagoons. The tropical forest trail winds through deep green tunnels of over 500 species of plants and culminates in a cooling dip in one of the eleven lagoons.</p>
Job Description	<p>The volunteer will assist the Punta Cana Ecological Foundation's maintenance of the Punta Cana Farm and ecological reserve. Volunteers will work from 9am to 4pm Monday through Friday. Duties include: trail maintenance, composting, administration of food for animals, cleaning animal habitats, general maintenance and monitoring wildlife.</p>
